

WORRY AND DISAPPOINTMENT

Parents are often worried and disappointed when their child has learning problems. There are many reasons for school failure, but a common one is a specific learning disability. A child with a learning disability is usually bright and initially tries very hard to follow instructions, concentrate and be good at home and in school. Yet despite this effort he or she is not mastering school tasks and falls behind. Some learning-disabled children also have trouble sitting still or paying attention. Learning disabilities affect as many as 15 percent of otherwise able school children.

SNOWBALL EFFECT

Child and adolescent psychiatrists point out that learning disabilities are treatable, but if not detected and treated early, they can have a tragic snowballing effect.

For instance, a child who does not learn addition in elementary school cannot understand algebra in high school. The child, trying very hard to learn, becomes more and more frustrated, and develops emotional problems such as low self-esteem in the face of repeated failure. Some learning-disabled children misbehave in school because they would rather be seen as bad or stupid.

Today more than ever it is important to strengthen each child's self-confidence and is vital for healthy development.

BE AWARE OF COMMON SIGNS OF LEARNING STRUGGLES IN YOUR CHILD

Has difficulty understanding and following instructions.

Has trouble remembering what someone just told him or her.

Fails to master reading, writing, and/or math skills, and thus fails schoolwork.

Has difficulty distinguishing right from left, for example, confusing 25 with 52, b with d or on with no.

Lack coordination in walking, sports, or small activities such as holding a pencil or tying a shoelace.

Easily loses or misplaces homework, schoolbooks or other items.

Cannot understand the concept of time; is confused by yesterday, today and tomorrow.
